Coastwatch Scotland Irvine is a registered charity in Scotland SC044309. Our aims are to keep a watching brief on all activities on the beaches, rivers and seas near Irvine. 'Eyes and Ears along the Coast for your safety'. To this end trained Coastwatch Volunteers patrol the harbour and beaches carrying a support bag with first aid kit, water, maps, compass, blanket, binoculars. We also operate from our central control room with all our maritime equipment eg GPS, radar, radios, NAVTEX, etc. We also have a boat section, although not everyone wishes to train on boats.

Most of our volunteers joined with little or no experience of things nautical and are now experienced and knowledgeable 'Coastwatchers'. We are recruiting new volunteers. Are you interested? Do you have spare time? Do you want to learn new skills? Do you want to meet new friends from many different backgrounds? We recruit men and women from 16 years with no age limit!

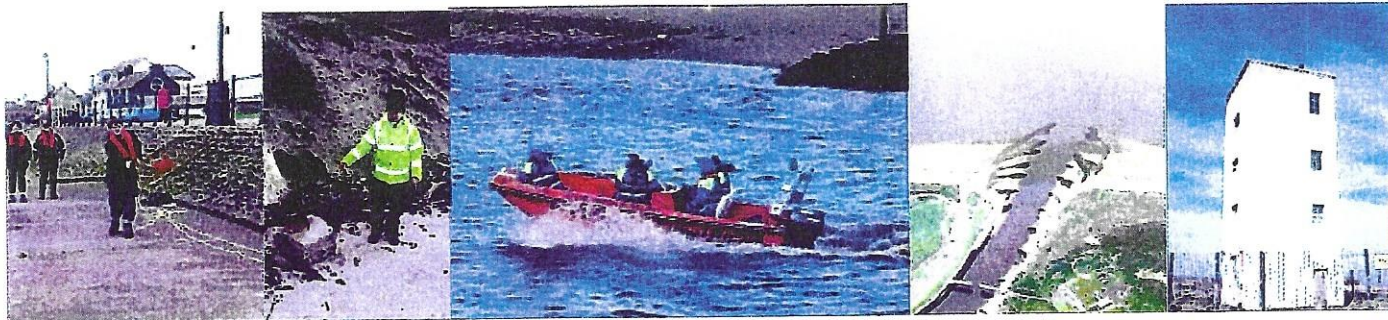
